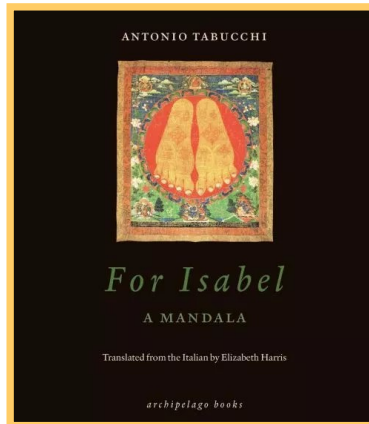


# Elizabeth Harris

**Elizabeth Harris** translates contemporary Italian fiction. Her translated books include Mario Rigoni Stern's novel *Giacomo's Seasons* (Autumn Hill Books), Giulio Mozzi's story collection *This Is the Garden* (Open Letter Books), and Antonio Tabucchi's novels *Tristano Dies* and *For Isabel: A Mandala* (both with Archipelago Books). For her various translations of Tabucchi, she has won a PEN/Heim Translation Fund Grant, an NEA Translation Fellowship, The Italian Prose in Translation Award, and the National Translation Award. She is currently translating Tabucchi's collection *Stories with Pictures* (forthcoming with Archipelago) and Francesco Pacifico's novel *The Women I Love* (forthcoming with Farrar, Straus and Giroux).
