

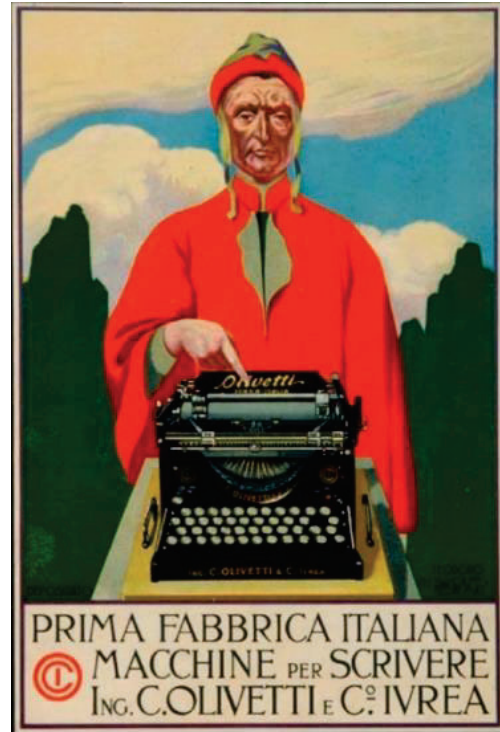

Italian 301 is a 3-credit course that provides students with reading knowledge of Italian. It is intended for undergraduate and graduate students with little or no knowledge of Italian who wish to develop proficiency in reading Italian texts, including graduate students who seek to fulfill their "*for reading knowledge*" requirement.

Intensive grammar; readings from appropriate texts in the humanities, social sciences, and current events.
